



New Police Liaison for Tawa

Constable Sarah Steed has been assigned as the liaison constable for Tawa, following a push from local MP Greg O'Connor for Kapiti Mana Police to assign a member of the Community Policing Team to Tawa to give residents a 'go to' person to deal with local issues.

Sarah, who began her policing career in the UK, has worked in Wellington and Porirua and is very keen to understand Tawa and Linden policing issues.

She points out that response policing which requires urgent attendance and follow-up enquiries will still be handled by the Porirua Police, and people should use the emergency and non-emergency numbers for routine policing issues and emergencies.

The emergency number is 111. The non-emergency number is 105.

What will be different is that Sarah will now have the overview of the policing situation in Tawa which can sometimes be lacking without the presence of someone who has a focus on the area.
